<u>Canadian Vocational Training Centre (CVTC)</u> is designated by the <u>Private Training Institutions</u> <u>Branch</u> (PTIB) of the British Columbia Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training.

Before you enrol at CVTC, we will advise you of your rights and responsibilities while in attendance at CVTC.

Policy:

You have the right to be treated **fairly** and **respectfully** by CVTC.

You have the right to a **student enrolment contract** that includes the following information:

- amount of tuition and any additional fees for your program
- refund policy
- if your program includes a work experience, the requirements to participate in the work experience and the geographic area where it will be provided
- whether the program was approved by PTIB or does not require approval.

Make sure you read the contract before signing. CVTC will provide you with a signed copy.

You have the right to access the institution's **dispute resolution process** and to be **protected against retaliation** for making a complaint.

You have the right to make a **claim** to PTIB for a **tuition refund** if:

- CVTC ceased to hold a certificate before you completed an approved program
- you were misled about a significant aspect of your approved program at CVTC.

You must file the claim within **one year** of completing, being dismissed or withdrawing from your program.
